TRICYCLIC ANTIDEPRESSANTS (TCAs) Side Effects:

Medications in this category: Amitriptyline (Elavil), Clomipramine (Anafranil), Desipramine (Norpramin), Imipramine (Tofranil), Nortriptyline capsules (Pamelor)

Most common: sedation, dry mouth, constipation, weight gain, sexual side effects, delay when starting to pass urine (urinary hesitation), blurred vision.

Serious but rare: seizures, cardiac effects (head rush or lightheadedness upon standing, arrhythmias, QT prolongation, and AV block.)

Pregnancy: Relatively large database; recent meta-analysis of 300,000 live births revealed no increased risk of birth defects. Neonatal anticholinergic effects (constipation, dry mouth, difficulty passing urine). Transient neonatal withdrawal symptoms reported.
